Dear participants,

The team is happy to welcome you to this wonderful training course, a process like a living creature, inspired and evolving by inputs of all the involved participants.

This training will take place in October, 2017 in Drobeta Turnu Severin, Romania. It will be hosted by Youthopolis (Romania). The TC will bring together 40 participants from 8 organizations from all over EU.

The training addresses 40 young people' need to develop their competences and to multiply the project's outcomes within their local communities. The main target group is composed of

Participants' countries are the following: Romania, the Netherlands, Italy, Greece, Macedonia, Denmark, Turkey and Spain.

What the project is about?

Knowledge and innovation are seen as the beating heart of European growth. Little time ago, the European Council stated that European citizens' potential for creativity and innovation is essential for future growth. The Council of Europe emphasizes the importance of creativity, knowledge, flexibility and innovation in a time of rapid technological change as they enhance citizens' well-being and provide careers opportunities.

Although we are supported to develop creativity and creative skills from the highest level, our local realities demonstrated that the results have not been visible so far, at least not to the desirable extend. Therefore, we identified the following needs:

- schools do not encourage creative thinking, due to the overburden curricula and lack of use of NFE tools as integrated part of the learning process
- employers require a lot of creative thinking
- young people are less interested in creative thinking, as they associate it with art (music, dance, theatre).

Young people in our organizations believe that training their creative skills will help them feel more confident, tune in with their inner drive, understand their unique voice and take active steps to reach their personal and professional goals.

As youth workers supporting young people development and learning process, we need to increase and extend spaces for the kind of education that will promote creative thinking.

By using interactive and non-formal methods, the participants will become highly involved in the project and will be able to develop their own skills and practical knowledge. The training working principles are based on experiential pedagogy. Moreover, they will be motivated to continue sharing the knowledge afterwards in their home country and within their own organization.

Profile of the participant:

- age (18-24 years old)
- interest in Erasmus+ programme in general and youth exchange projects in particular
- committed to be actively involved in planning, organizing, implementing of the activities of the project
- committed to disseminate the results within their organizations and to multiply the impact of the project by actively working with peer youth in their local communities
- interested in finding solution for the identified needs in a non-formal learning context
- minimum working level of English (B1 to C2, according to Common European Framework of Reference for Languages).

Priority to selection will be given to participants with fewer opportunities (cultural, geographical, economical) and/or participants at their first international experience.

The YE will be implemented in the frames of the “Erasmus+” programme of the European Commission and was financially supported by the Romanian National Agency.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE:

Arrival: 4th November, 2017 to **Drobeta Turnu Severin, Romania**

Departure: 11th November, 2017 from **Drobeta Turnu Severin, Romania**

Activities days: 5-10 November 2017

TRAVEL TO ROMANIA:

There are 2 options for flying to Romania: Timișoara Airport and Bucharest airport.

For those who will arrive to Traian Vuia Timișoara Airport:

From the airport you take Express bus (E4b), which makes connection from airport to central station. The price of one ticket is 2.5 lei (1.8 Euros). You need to buy the ticket from the cashier. Payment can be done either cash or with the card. In the airport hall you will find a currency exchange office.

From Timișoara Central station (Timișoara Nord) you take the train to Drobeta Turnu Severin. Here is the link to departing time from Timișoara.

The hotel is close to the station, 10 minute walk maximum.

For those who will arrive to Otopeni Bucharest Airport:

Take bus Express 780 to the Central station (Gara de Nord). There is a bus approximately every 40 minutes, from 5 am to 11 pm. The price of a ticket round way is 9 lei (2 Euro).

From the Central Station, take the train to Drobeta Turnu Severin.

In case the groups will arrive at approximately the same time, we will organize a private transport from the airport to the venue of the activities.

We strongly recommend you to check with the organizers the travel option you choose. Please note that the organizers will not cover any accommodation and food costs outside the project dates.

Please, check the **validity of the IDs/passports** before the departure.

TRAVEL COSTS:

The organizers will reimburse the transport expenses, according with the distance bands, after the mobility.

Participants will be reimbursed by bank transfer shortly after their return home upon presenting original tickets, invoices and boarding passes.

- Please note that travel costs of the participants should **not exceed the travel budget limits**, which was approved by the Executive agency. Please refer to the table below for travel **budget limits** for each partner organization.
- Reimbursement of travel costs will be done upon presentation of **all** (including return tickets) **original tickets, receipts/invoices and boarding passes**. Name of the passenger, price, currency, date of purchase should be clearly **visible** in all documents to be considered for reimbursement. Please remember to bring the original invoice – there will be no reimbursement without the original invoice.
- **If a participant is planning to arrive early or depart**, please consult with us prior to booking the tickets to make sure it is in the limits of the funder's requirements, otherwise we may not be able to provide full reimbursement. Usually one day before and one day after the event is acceptable.
- Participants **planning to travel from/to another country other than the one they represent in the YE** need to check with us prior to the training course, as otherwise we may not be able to reimburse their travel costs.
- **Reimbursement transferred by bank account will be done in EUR** regardless of the currency indicated on your ticket, receipt or invoice. Any ticket purchased in local currency other than EUR will be converted and calculated according to the exchange rate of the day the contract was signed when the ticket was purchased according to official European Commission website <http://ec.europa.eu/budget/inforeuro/index.cfm?Language=en>
- We strongly advise you to make copies of your tickets and invoices before you will come to the training and send all your travel original documents to youthopolis.ro@gmail.com
