Thanks to the variety and interdependency of our human and professional resources, our activities range touches different areas: education, training, social development, cultural promotion, environmental protection, human rights, inclusion, gender studies and equal opportunities.

CONTEXT AND OBJECTIVES



The most recent EU Youth Reports indicated that sadly more than 13 millions of youth (15 – 29) all over the Europe are not in Employment, Education and Training (NEET), The trend show a constant increasing but at the same time public Institutions in most part all over Europe seems to not be able to carry out specific and strategic actions to face this situation. The Paris Declaration 2015 acknowledges that youth represent the future and that the work done to build on youth's sense of initiative and participation must be collective and reinforces.

On the other hand working with young people requires youth workers who continuously increase their competences to improve the quality of their work, learn and practice new methods. For this reason 'imPACT' project is designed to improve the quality of youth work especially focused and addressed at youth at risk of exclusion, NEET or young people with fewer opportunity.

AIM

'imPACT' consists on a week training course addressed to youth workers from different countries and designed to offer new skills and tools to enhances competences and knowledge of youth workers working with NEET and in general working with young people in need.



The main aim of the training course is to give youth workers specific educational tools for project based-youth in need work. The tools and the methods will be structured in order to pursue a double path: on on hand to improve professional specific skills, on the other hand to increase awareness about NEET and youth at risk and the situation in different European countries.

More specific objectives:

- To develop deep understanding of the issues related to youth at risk, especially NEETs and youth with fewer opportunities;
- To increase the capacity of youth workers to empower youth at risk, especially NEETs and youth with fewer opportunities;

- To increase their employability and initiative spirit;
- To provide concrete learning tools and methods for developing life skills for this specific youth target;
- To enable a sharing of good practices among partners' organizations and participants;
- To increase motivation of youth worker to work with youth at risk, especially NEETs and with fewer opportunities;
- To create the space for follow up cooperation activities among partner organizations, focusing on youth at risk, especially NEETs and youth with fewer opportunities.

TRAINING CONTENT AND METHODOLOGY

The TC consists of 6 full training days on which participants have the chance to experience and explore different theoretical concepts, tools and methods connected with youth education, with focus on youth at risk of exclusion. Outdoor activities, discussions, role-playing, workshops and green life-style will give participants the chance to empower themselves in order to turn critical reflection into action in the field of education. Participants will undergo, in first person, the tools and the instruments in order to better understand methodology, strategy and techniques.



The course is based on non-formal education principles and methods, thus the participants will play an active role in the learning process.

PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

We are searching **21 participants** coming from **Germany, Portugal, Slovenia, Croatia, France, Romania, Bulgaria, Cyprus, Estonia, Spain and Italy**. So, each partner organization is kindly asked to send 2 participants (except for Bulgarian partner that will participate with just 1 participant).



Partners will be kindly asked also to ensure a proper preparation of their participants.

Participants are:

- Youth workers (youth leaders, coaches, teachers, mentors) and volunteers, including people with fewer opportunities, who want to develop new competences and skills.
- Participants should be willing to use their competences after the training course in their own realities.
- Participants should be at least 18 years.

DATES AND VENUE

The TC will take place in Calalzo di Cadore, Italy from 16th to 23th of May (travel day included). More information on how to reach the place will be included in the Info-pack and sent after selection of participants is completed.
